# TARGUS DEFCON™ CL

## Introduction

Thank you for purchasing the Targus DEFCON CL Notebook Computer Cable Lock. The DEFCON CL helps protect your valuable notebook computer from theft using a resettable four-digit combination lock. The resettable combination lock eliminates the need for keys and enables you to change your combination periodically for increased security.

In addition to this user's guide, this package contains:

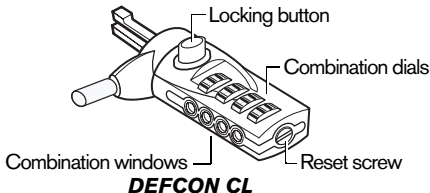

**WARNING:** To use the DEFCON CL or reset the combination you must set the lock to the current combination.

## Setting the Combination

- 1 Locate the combination dials and windows on the lock.

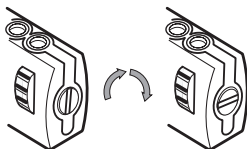


- 2 Using the dials, enter the current combination.

If you are setting the combination for the first time, enter the preset combination 0000.

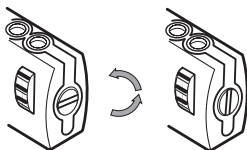
The combination appears in the windows.

- Using a small flat-head screwdriver or similar object, push in and rotate the reset screw 90 degrees clockwise so that the screw's groove appears horizontal.



### ***Unlocking the combination lock***

- Using the dials, enter the new combination.
- Rotate the reset screw 90 degrees counterclockwise, back to its original vertical position, to save the new combination.



### ***Locking the combination lock***

- Record the combination in either the space provided at the end of this guide or another secure, easy-to-find place.

## **Testing the Combination**

Before attaching the lock to your notebook computer:

- Turn the dials to disguise the combination.
- Return to the combination you set.
- Check that the locking button depresses completely.

## Securing the DEFCON CL

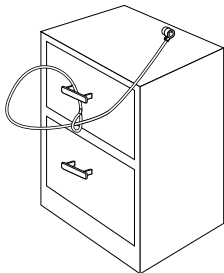
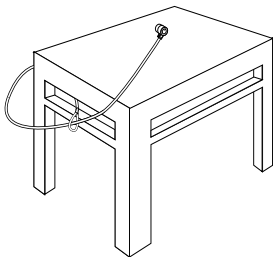
Select an object in the room to which you will secure your notebook computer with the DEFCON CL. Choose a large, heavy piece of furniture such as a table or desk, or an immovable fixture such as a closet hanging bar.

- 1 Take the looped end of the cable and wrap it around the selected object.



**NOTE:** WRAP THE CABLE AROUND A PART OF THE OBJECT THAT WILL DETER AN INTRUDER FROM SLIPPING THE CABLE OFF (FOR EXAMPLE, A TABLE OR DESK LEG WITH A CROSS BAR OR A DRAWER HANDLE).

- 2 Feed the lock through the looped end of the cable as shown.



***Securing the DEFCON CL to an object***

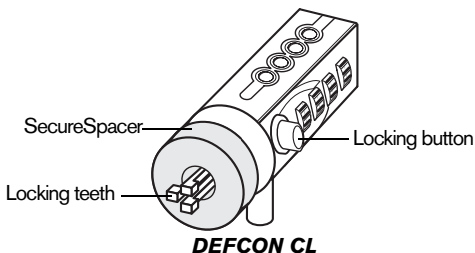
## Locking the DEFCON CL to your Notebook Computer



**NOTE:** HOLD THE DEFCON CL WITH BOTH HANDS FOR ADDITIONAL STABILITY WHILE INSERTING OR REMOVING THE LOCK.

- 1 Using the dials, enter the correct combination.

The combination appears in the windows.



- 2 Press and hold the locking button to align the locking teeth.



**NOTE:** FOR THE LOCKING BUTTON TO DEPRESS COMPLETELY YOU MUST ENTER THE CORRECT COMBINATION.

- 3 Insert the DEFCON CL into your notebook computer's lock slot and release the locking button.



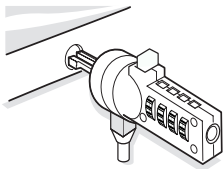
**NOTE:** DUE TO THE VARIATION IN THE SIZE OF THE SECURITY SLOTS ON VARIOUS NOTEBOOK MODELS, YOU MAY FIND THAT THERE IS SOME SLACK BETWEEN THE LOCK AND THE COMPUTER. THE SUPPLIED DEFCON SecureSPACERS ARE THE BEST SOLUTION FOR OPTIMAL FIT AND SECURITY.

- 4 Turn the dials to conceal your combination.

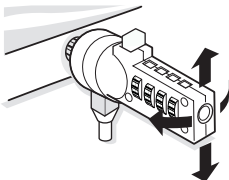
Due to differences in the size of the security slots on various notebook computers, you may find that there is some slack between the DEFCON locking device and the computer. The DEFCON SecureSpacers provide optimal fit and security.

## Using the DEFCON SecureSpacers

- 1 Insert your DEFCON locking device into the computer's lock slot.



- 2 Pull the DEFCON locking device away from the computer and check whether the gap is excessive.



- 3 If so, try each of the SecureSpacers to determine which one fits the gap. The SecureSpacers come in three sizes: 1.6 mm, 0.8 mm, and 0.4 mm.



**NOTE:** DO NOT REMOVE THE ADHESIVE STRIP FROM ANY OF THE SECURESPACERS UNTIL YOU DECIDE WHICH ONE TO USE.

- 4 Once you know which SecureSpacer you are going to use, remove the locking device from the computer. Then remove the adhesive strip from the back of the SecureSpacer and attach the spacer to the DEFCON lock.

# Unlocking the DEFCON CL



**WARNING:** DO NOT ATTEMPT TO REMOVE THE DEFCON CL WITHOUT USING THE COMBINATION. TO DO SO WILL PHYSICALLY DAMAGE YOUR NOTEBOOK COMPUTER.

- 1 Using the dials, enter the correct combination.
- 2 The combination appears in the windows.
- 3 Press and hold the locking button to realign the locking teeth.
- 4 Remove the DEFCON CL from your notebook computer's lock slot.

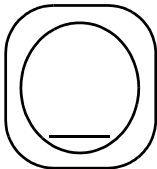
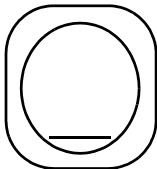
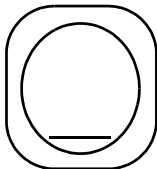
# Recording Your Combination
