### APA95AU-50, 45W USB-C PD3.0 LAPTOP WALL CHARGER

Important safety information if you have purchased a Targus APA95AU-50 Laptop Wall Charger in Australia or NZ. Each unit is supplied with an Australian/NZ AC plug head.



#### What is the issue?

Targus has become aware that, when unplugging the charger from the power socket, there is a potential on some units for the faceplate to separate from the body of the AC plug head, exposing live parts, presenting a risk of electric shock.



#### What is the hazard?

Currently available information indicates that the risk may arise if the user attempts to unplug the unit from a power source while the power source is still switched on. The safety of end-users of our products is of paramount importance to Targus, and so as a matter of abundant caution we are undertaking a product recall of the APA95AU-50 in Australia and NZ.

## WHAT SHOULD YOU DO?

- Do NOT attempt to unplug your APA95AU-50 charger without SWITCHING OFF the power to the charger at the power source;
- If you are not certain that the power has been switched off, seek
  qualified help to confirm the power is off and to remove the charger
  safely; and

**Defect:** There is potential on some units for the faceplate to separate from the body of the AC plug head and expose live parts.
